




# Labor force participation is lagging.



# CHANGE IN MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME BY METRO AREA





#### POVERTY RATES IN CORE CITIES OF THE TEN LARGEST US METROS



# **EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT BY METRO AREA**














40% faster growth than non-exporters




20% higher wages than non-exporters









#### **ANNUAL EXPORT GROWTH, NAICS-3**



Many small and mid-sized companies have limited awareness of their global growth potential or of existing export services.


