
# Smart City in Russia: current situation

- •Very first stage of development vision creation, and local initiatives, but with lack of common targets or initiatives
- •But it's very popular: dozens of projects has appeared in several cities, municipals try to design a Smart City
- •Most of strategies describes Smart City as a "very good place" (comfortable, modern, lean), but we do not have a solid and complex tech-paradigm-city plan (strategy)
- •Compared with Europe, we still have a policy lag, regarding clusters, testbeds, business player ecosystem

## Smart City in Russia: some cases

- •Existing solutions developed through Smart City projects in Russia mainly deal with physical infrastructure, mobility and utilities technologies, while social and institutional factors are yet to be considered.
- Moscow Smart City Program aimed at large-scale use of information and communication technologies, improving efficiency and transparency of the city administration, developing municipal advertising and mass media in areas: health, education, facilities, safety
- •Kazan Smart City is a groundbreaking urban development project designed to spur investment into high technology, medicine, education, and tourism. Usage of integrated intelligent solutions by Cisco
- •Nijniy Tagil Smart and safety City Plan integration of electronic information signs, light poles and intelligent road markings based on Schwabe holding solutions

We consider Smart city as an open cyber physical system with many new types of digital services, as well as new users -



## Smart City in Russia: the next stage crossroads

- •Top-down: large governmental projects in different areas, like program Safety City («Bezopasniy Gorod») - digital platform, which provides protection of critical infrastructure of cities and people's safety – first in monopolies
- •Bottom-up: business and communities of practice, that change the landscapes and culture: city platforms, commons, apps... - first in unregulated markets
